REQUIRED SCHOOL ACCOUNTS

SMART TUITION Account - Westover uses Smart Tuition to administer its tuition and fee billing. Each family is required to have a Smart Tuition account through which the School will bill ONLY contracted tuition items – net tuition, tuition refund plan, consolidated fee, and international students services fee. No additional charges will be added to your tuition account during the course of the school year. Information regarding your Smart Tuition account will be sent to you electronically once your enrollment agreement is accepted by Westover School.

MyKidsSpending Account (MKS) Our Student Debit Account - All other charges, fees and incidental expenses will be billed through your student debit account. This includes school store and snack bar purchases, transportation to and from non-school activities, art, photo and ESL course fees, and music lessons. To facilitate billing, we require each family to set up a student debit MyKidsSpending account from which you can monitor your daughter's student debit account and replenish it as needed throughout the year. Information regarding your student debit account will be sent to you electronically once your enrollment agreement is accepted by Westover School.

MKS Initial Deposit and beginning school year balance (due between July 15 and July 31, 2018):

Boarding and International Students: \$1,500.00

Day Students: \$750.00

The International Student Services Fee (\$2,150) - Westover recognizes the additional needs and support that international students require. This fee provides a full-time Director of Global Program, an international advisor, ongoing training and professional development of faculty and staff, and special programs for international students. These programs consist of vacation support through travel programs offered during school breaks, organizing host families for interested students, and funding student overnight trips. This fee includes SEVIS management which supports students with the issuance and maintenance of I-20 forms as well as maintaining their F-1 visa status.

TUITION PAYMENT OPTION

Parents can choose one of three payment plans through Smart Tuition:

Single Pay Plan, due June 30, 2018

The Tuition Refund Plan is not required for families opting for this payment plan, however, it is strongly suggested that families consider taking advantage of the TRP when choosing this payment plan. If a family will opt out of paying the TRP, they must sign and return our Waiver of Tuition Refund Plan form with their contracts.

Two Pay Plan, with equal payments due the 15th of July and November.

Smart Tuition assesses a \$50 administrative fee for this payment plan. The Tuition Refund Plan is required for families choosing this payment plan.

10-Payment Plan, with payments paid in 10 equal installments beginning July, 2018 and ending April, 2018, administered through Smart Tuition. Smart Tuition assesses a \$50 administrative fee for this payment plan. The Tuition Refund Plan is required for families choosing this payment plan.

Payments can be made via check or credit card through Smart Tuition online, over the phone or by mail, and can be set up as automatic electronic debit through your checking account or credit card. All families will be set up to receive emailed invoices.

Payments can also be sent directly to the school by check or wire. Domestic families can wire payments through Bank United and international families can wire payments using Flywire by peerTransfer.

EXPLANATION OF FEES

The Tuition Refund Plan (TRP) - The fee is calculated as 2.0 percent of net tuition cost (tuition less financial aid) and is Required for both the Two-Pay and 10-Pay Plans (single payment plan enrollees are not required to have TRP, but are strongly urged to take advantage of the TRP). Please note that this is a change from past policies. TRP will partially reimburse tuition (prepaid and due) in the event of absence or separation, after 14 days from the first day of classes, according to the terms described in the TRP enclosed brochure.

The Consolidated Fee - In order to make the costs of Westover more predictable, we have consolidated several fees that occur during the course of the year. These include: Health Center Fee, which provides for stays in the School Health Center, all consultations with the Physician's Assistant or School Physician, athletic trainer, all non-prescription medications, medical supplies, and laboratory services performed at the Health Center; a Technology Fee to provide for computer set-up, e-mail and internet access for each student. The fee also includes a yearbook for each student and transportation Friday and Saturday evenings to a local mall or movie-theater.

Note: The fee does not provide for medical treatment outside of the School at local hospitals and doctors' offices. All students are required to have health insurance with a U.S. carrier for this purpose. International Students: see below.

Health Insurance - All students are required to have health insurance and show the School proof thereof. International students are required to either show proof of US based health insurance or they must purchase health insurance through ISM. Domestic students outside of a 100 mile radius of Westover School may also purchase health insurance through ISM.

Enrollment in English as a Second Language (ESL) (\$700 per trimester) – Required of any international student whose first language is not English, unless she can demonstrate, based upon a TOEFL test, that her level of English competence is sufficient to enable her a passing grade in our regular English program. This fee is billed to your Student Debit Account when applicable.
