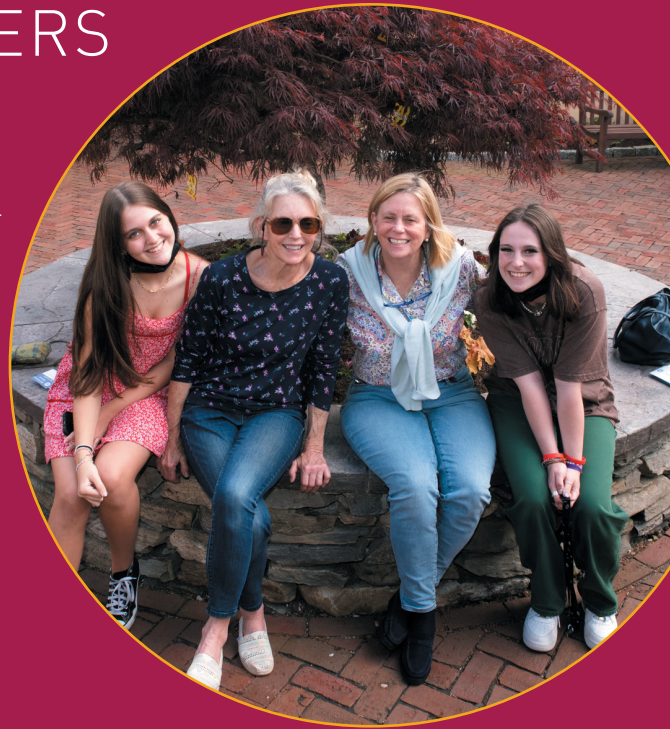

1972

THE ADELE Q. ERVIN '42 AWARD is presented to the reunion class with the most exceptional results in overall fundraising for Westover. Adele’s formidable fundraising legacy included roles as a Governor, Trustee, first Director of Alumnae Relations, and founder of the Alumnae Association. This year’s award was given to the **Class of 1972**, whose 2021–22 fundraising initiative raised over \$37,983.

1977

THE JULIA B. KIRLIN AWARD, named for the long-serving staff member and one of the founders of Westover’s Development program, is presented to the reunion class that has achieved the best results in overall fundraising participation. This year the award was given to the **Class of 1977**, who achieved 78% participation. This remarkable achievement is an inspiration to the community and a testament to the trust and pride our alumnae have in the school.

THE ALUMNAE BOARD OF GOVERNORS AWARD is presented to the 5th, 10th, or 15th reunion class with the highest percentage participation in overall fundraising efforts. This year, the award was given to the **Class of 2007** for achieving 43% participation.

Financial Aid

The Westover Fund helps provide access to a Westover education for a talented and diverse student body representing a broad range of backgrounds.

Academics

The Westover Fund supports a robust, creative curriculum, including signature programs such as Women in Science and Engineering, Invest in Girls and programming through the Rasin Center for Global Justice.

Arts

Each year, over 90% of students take one or more arts courses, developing skills to see clearly, listen acutely, think critically, and explore creatively so that they can express themselves with confidence.

Athletics

The Westover Fund supports the entire Athletics program from team sports to yoga and dance classes that contribute to a culture of intellectual, physical, and personal development.

Student Life

Faculty and Staff

ANNOUNCING THE DR. MIRIAM DeCOSTA-WILLIS '52 AWARD FOR SOCIAL JUSTICE

Westover is proud to announce the 2022 establishment of the Dr. Miriam DeCosta-Willis '52 Award for Social Justice. This award is in celebration of an alum who has made a significant contribution in the advancement of social justice through their advocacy, activism, and leadership.



Dr. DeCosta-Willis believed that education was a tool that positioned one to give back. She blazed many trails and was an activist, an academician, an author, and the first African American student at Westover.

Dr. DeCosta-Willis was a civil rights activist, professor, and author. She was Westover's first African American graduate. She was also the first Black graduate with a Ph.D. from Johns Hopkins University and, in 1965, was the first Black faculty member at Memphis State University.

A college professor and administrator for more than 40 years, Dr. DeCosta-Willis began her career in 1957, teaching French at LeMoyne College. She later taught French and English at Owen Junior College. In 1966 she became the first black faculty member at Memphis State University, first as assistant professor and later as an associate professor of Spanish. She joined the faculty of Howard University in 1970 and was elected chair of the Department of Romance Languages four years later. From 1979 to 1989, she served as professor of Romance Languages at LeMoyne-Owen College, where she founded and directed the Du Bois Scholars Program. In 1989, she was appointed Commonwealth Professor of Spanish at George Mason University. She completed her career as a professor and Director of Graduate Studies in the Department of African American Studies at the University of Maryland, Baltimore County. She retired in 1999.

Miriam authored, edited, or co-edited 15 books. Over the course of her career, Dr. DeCosta-Willis received several fellowships and awards, including a Johns Hopkins Fellowship, Wellesley

College Fellowship for Graduate Study, Outstanding Faculty Member of the Year Award, Prominent Black Woman Award, Torchbearer of Afro-Hispanic Studies, Carter G. Woodson Award, and the Martin Luther King, Jr. Award.

An activist throughout her life, Dr. DeCosta-Willis organized a student protest at Wilkinson High School, joined her mother in the Montgomery Bus Boycott, and was jailed in Memphis for participating in civil rights demonstrations. She served as advisor to the Black Students Association, campaigned for Black political candidates, and, as chair of the Memphis NAACP's Education Committee, led a boycott of local public schools in the 1960s, and joined protest marches in Washington in the 1990s.

Dr. DeCosta-Willis was a life member of the NAACP, chaired the Tennessee Humanities Council, and served on the boards of the Federation of State Humanities Councils, Shelby County Historical Commission, and MSU Center for Research on Women. As co-founder and chair of the Memphis Black Writers' Workshop, she organized symposia such as "The Memphis Story . . . Lest We Forget: 1950-1980," put together a Black History series for WHBQ-TV Channel 13, and co-edited **Homespun Images: An Anthology of Black Memphis Writers and Artists**. Dr. DeCosta-Willis received the inaugural award which was accepted in her memory by her son Judge Tarik B. Sugarmon.

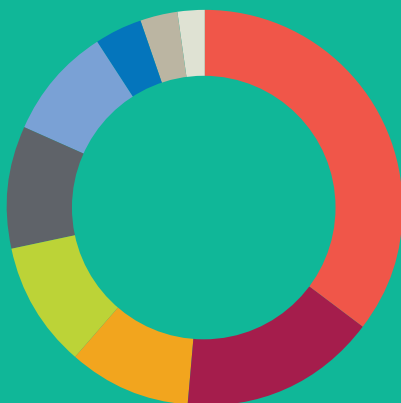


2021-2022 OPERATING BUDGET

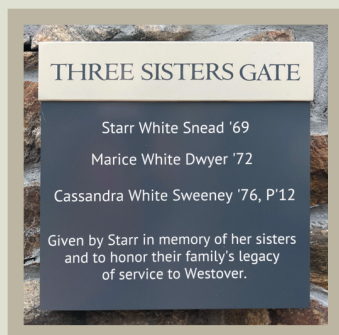

DEDICATION OF THE THREE SISTERS GATE

The high stone wall that encloses the South Street side of Westover is now graced by a new, black iron gate—complete with three gold-painted Tudor roses—that allows passersby a glimpse into the School's Senior Garden, one of the most beautiful corners of the campus.



During reunion last May, a group of alumnae and other members of Westover's community gathered for the dedication of the Three Sisters Gate, made possible by a gift from the outgoing Trustee President, Starr White Snead '69, in memory of her sisters—Marice White Dwyer '72 and Cassandra

nobody ever had seen from the outside because of the original gate and the stone wall. Now you can see how lovely it is."

At the dedication, classmates of Muffy and Candy spoke of the impact they had within their classes' Westover experiences.

In her remarks, Annie DiSesa McHugh '72 praised Muffy's creativity, artistry, and leadership skills. "We remember Muffy's beautiful smile . . . and the fact that she was maybe a little more mature than the rest of us. She remained a loyal friend and was a champion of Westover."

White Sweeney '76, P'12—and to honor their family's legacy of service to Westover.

At the dedication, Associate Head of School Ben Hildebrand noted that the new gate replaced the original green wooden gate that had stood for more than a century, but which had fallen into "a state of disrepair" before being dismantled several years ago.

When Starr's classmates were considering a 50th Reunion class gift in 2019, a new gate for Senior Garden was one of several proposals suggested. Ultimately, another project was chosen.

But the proposal had given Starr an idea of how to celebrate her family's legacy at Westover. Inspired by a gift she had made to Wheaton College—where she, Muffy, and Candy had attended—to set up the Three Sisters Scholarship Fund, she created the Three Sisters Gate idea for Westover. And, as a longtime resident of Charleston, South Carolina, Starr had been struck by the beauty of the many wrought-iron gates that grace its neighborhoods.

Over the next several years of the pandemic, the design and construction of the gate evolved before it was installed in the spring of 2022.

"What I love the most about the new gate," Starr said, "is that the garden is one of the prettiest parts of the campus, but it's one that

Inspired by Muffy's love of art and art history, her enduring legacy at Westover includes a fund established by her husband's law partners following her death in 1989. Every four years, the fund underwrites the Muffy White Dwyer Arts Day, a day-long program for the entire school community that celebrates either the performing arts or studio arts.

In her remarks about her classmate Candy, Governor Kristin Hartley Leithiser '76 said, "When I think of Candy . . . I think of grace—the grace that is seen in elegance of movement, the grace that is seen in courteous good will toward others, the grace bestowed in blessings from above." Kristin also reflected on the example Candy offered through her courage and eloquence in the face of the cancer which took her life in 2017.

Candy's daughter, Keelin Sweeney '12, noted that her mother "was a lifelong educator," so that it was significant "to have her memorialized at Westover, her favorite place in the entire world—besides, perhaps, a beach," she added with a laugh.

In her mother's frequent visits to Westover—both as a parent and as a Trustee—Keelin witnessed "the really special connection I got to watch my mom develop with all of my friends . . . she was kind of all of our moms."

After the dedication, Starr noted that Candy's commitment to supporting families at Westover led her to establish The Mary Griscom Holmes 1919 Scholarship Fund—named in memory of their grandmother—to support families who have two or more students attending Westover simultaneously.

In her remarks, outgoing Head of School Julie Faulstich said, "Starr has been a transformative Board Chair for the School—endlessly dedicated for what is best for the students here through all the work that she has done and all the relationships she has formed," both as a Westover volunteer and as a consultant to independent schools for almost five decades.

In addition to Keelin and their grandmother, the three sisters' legacy alumnae include their late mother, Anne Holmes White '47,

and two aunts, Cuchi White Boni '47 and the late Mimsey Holmes Smith '50.

As Kristin noted, "It is in this gate that the spirit of family and Westover melds and lingers." Though she was speaking of Candy, Kristin may have also summed up the impact that all three sisters and the other members of the family have had at Westover:

"How like Candy a gate is. Like her arms, open; like her heart, open; . . . welcoming everyone in with grace and love."

LESHER FAMILY FOUNDATION GIFT SUPPORTS WISE PROGRAM

In the years since her graduation, Rachel Stock Leshner '01 has remained connected to the School, both as a class correspondent and as a faithful donor to the Westover Fund. So, when a student volunteer texted Rachel this past year to thank her for her most recent Westover Fund gift, Rachel saw an opportunity to do even more for the School.

"I texted her back to say that I wanted to speak to someone in the Alumnae Office to make a more significant gift to Westover," Rachel recalled.

That exchange led to a series of discussions between Rachel and Hillary Dooley, Former Director of the Westover Fund, that resulted in a major annual gift to the School from the newly-formed Leshner Family Foundation (LFF). The gift supports both programming for the Women in Science and Engineering (WISE) curriculum and a portion of the WISE Director's salary and benefits.

"I had been giving to the School on a very small scale since I graduated," Rachel explained, "but I knew that at some point I hoped to have an opportunity to make a larger impact on behalf of the School."

That opportunity came in the past year. "This was the inaugural year of our family foundation," Rachel said, "and women's empowerment is one of the thematic focus areas of the foundation."

Since the WISE program was founded in the early 1990s in collaboration with Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute, it has become one of the signature programs supporting Westover's mission. Over the past three decades, WISE has prepared a growing number of Westover graduates to pursue science and engineering fields in college, areas in which women are typically underrepresented, and to ultimately become leaders in their chosen careers.

WISE courses provide real-world application to the fields of science and engineering. Through student-centered, hands-on experiential learning, WISE students gain

confidence to think critically about the world around them, helping to cultivate global awareness so they can lead lives of consequence. They are challenged to think critically and creatively in problem-solving, collaboration, communication, and documentation.

In the last five years, just over 70 percent of Westover's WISE graduates have entered college intending majors in science, technology, engineering, and mathematics. Nineteen members of the Class of 2022 graduated with WISE certification.

More than 80 students currently participate in the program each year. All Westover students are required to take the first WISE introductory course, Creative Problem-Solving, in 9th grade; 40 percent of students on average elect to continue the WISE program, taking the second course, introduction to WISE/Arts, and beyond.

To initiate the foundation's gift, Rachel submitted her proposal to other family members for their consideration.

"As I began to think about the programs I have vetted and supported personally over the years," Rachel wrote in her proposal, "Westover came to mind immediately . . . I attribute many of my early college successes to what I learned and experienced at Westover."

"Westover's mission," Rachel continued, "is to 'empower young women to lead lives of consequence,' and that resonates with LFF's values. The WISE program provides a way for girls to have an experiential learning opportunity in science and engineering before heading into college as they contemplate next steps in their

careers. This opportunity weaves together Math, English, Arts, and Theater in a multidisciplinary environment—providing hands-on experiences in critical thinking, problem solving, etc.”

In the conclusion to her proposal to LFF, Rachel wrote, “Westover School has enriched my life in profound ways—providing opportunities to grow and advance beyond the classroom. The WISE program is a testament to how Westover is preparing girls to lead—and to go out into the world and to make a true difference.”

Even though the foundation’s activities thus far have concentrated on geographic areas where family members reside, Rachel said her family was excited to support Westover School and, specifically, the WISE program.

Weighing in the WISE program’s favor, Rachel noted, “is that it’s a proven program with a track record of success,” and that the LFF funds are “delivering services directly to support program and students.”

Reflecting on her own Westover experience, Rachel noted that she came to the School as a new junior. Although she was not in the WISE program, she added, “what was so great about Westover was that there were so many other programs that you could participate in,” offering experiences that helped Rachel prepare both for her studies in college and for her career.

As a student, Rachel said, “my passion was in public speaking and debate.” She also participated in the School’s Model UN program and was a senior co-head of the Chapel program.

“My time at Westover was short but fruitful,” Rachel recalled. “It was a safe community to share ideas. My writing skills, my self-esteem, my sense of independence, the opportunities to take part in discussions and to think critically within groups—all of that was nurtured at the School. It gave me experience and enhanced my confidence.”

“I used the skills I learned at Westover right after graduation,” Rachel said. “I got on a train and started my first internship working in Washington that summer for

my Congressman. Because of my Westover experience, I wasn’t your typical intern.” Because Rachel showed confidence and maturity, her duties included attending meetings as her Congressman’s representative and reporting back on the discussions.

Rachel later received a B.A. in Political Science from George Washington University and an M.P.A. from the American University School of Public Affairs. She has worked in fundraising for several organizations, most recently for United Way Worldwide as Director of Network Performance, Major and Transformational Giving. In turn, her professional expertise and experience have made her a valuable resource in helping to set up LFF.

In the future, Rachel added, she is looking forward to exploring possibilities to build on the collaboration between the School and LFF. “We would welcome additional conversations to better appreciate whether and where additional support to Westover might make sense, in addition to WISE.”

ALUMNAE GIFTS FUND SUMMER RENOVATIONS

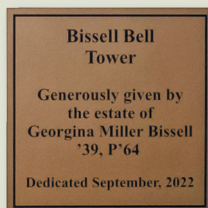
Thanks to the generous support of two very loyal alumnae, extensive renovations were completed during the summer of 2022 to the second and third floors corridors along the north side of Westover's main building facing the Middlebury Green.

"We were thrilled to continue the master-plan work of renovating the main building this summer," said Ben Hildebrand, associate head of school. "This project includes 11 offices on the second floor and 12 dorm rooms on Senior Corridor."

Six remaining corridors are in the queue for renovation and will be completed once the funding is in place, ideally completing two each summer for the next three years.

"Overall," Ben said, "the goal of this summer's project—as with past renovation work—is to retain the look and feel of the historic building, while dramatically improving the comfort and usability of the dorms and offices for our community. As a result, the spaces themselves should not look much different when we are finished, but will be far more functional and pleasing to live and work in."

CELEBRATING A LIFETIME OF SERVICE TO THE SCHOOL



The cost of the renovations was underwritten through a bequest to the School from the late Georgina "Gina" Miller Bissell '39 P'64, who passed away on June 3, 2020. Throughout her life, Gina remained a loyal and generous supporter, as well as a dedicated

volunteer on behalf of both her classmates and the entire School community.

"Having married early, my mother never went to college," said Lesley Bissell Hoopes '64, Gina's daughter. "So,

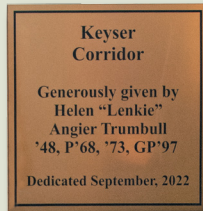
during her three years at Westover, she formed many of her lifelong friendships. In addition, she was so grateful to continue her relationship with the School that she served as a class secretary, a class agent, and a Trustee."

Because of Gina's long service to Westover, Lesley noted, "she was very honored to be given the Westover Award in 1989. It was her 50th Reunion and my 25th. I was so happy to be there to see her receive it!"

Reflecting on the fact her mother's bequest was used to fund the renovation project, Lesley said, "My mother would have been so pleased to know that her bequest will help the School's mission to ensure that future students receive the best educational experience in a competitive world. My mother was a strong believer in single-sex education, and felt that Westover provided girls with the self-confidence to be able to excel in college, as well as in life beyond school." Lesley added, "She treasured her time at the School—case in point: she kept her lantern for many years after her graduation."

To honor Gina's lifetime of service and generosity, the iconic bell tower on the main building has been named the Bissell Bell Tower. "Although my mother never actively sought recognition for her many gifts and accomplishments," Lesley said, "I know that she would have been very pleased to have the bell tower named after her," especially because the sound of the electronic bell carillon can be heard ringing from the tower every hour throughout the day "and is a part of daily life at Westover."

A CHALLENGE GIFT



Helen "Lenkie" Keyser Trumbull '48 P'68, '63 GP'97, another long-time volunteer and generous supporter of the School, made a gift during the 2021–2022 school year to underwrite the renovations made on Senior Corridor.

It will officially be known as the Keyser Corridor. Lenkie's gift is intended to challenge others to support this critical project so that all boarding students can benefit from the renovations and Westover can end its reliance on outdated infrastructure.

Like Gina, Lenkie has served as a volunteer in a multiple of roles on behalf of Westover for more than seven decades, including Trustee, Reunion Gift Chair, Second Century Campaign Volunteer, Class Correspondent, and Peer Fundraiser.

In recognition of her long commitment to Westover, she was named a Life Trustee and has also received the Maria Randall Allen '42 Volunteer Award. She is a member of The Hillard Society for designating Westover as a beneficiary in her planned giving, and The Cogitare Agere Esse Society, which recognizes those friends of the School who have made substantial contributions to Westover. In recognition of Lenkie's past contributions to the School, other named spaces on campus include the Angier Squash Pavilion & Vestibule and the Helen Angier Trumbull '48 Keyser Cafe.

Lenkie credits the reasons for her generous support for the School throughout her life simply but directly: "I loved all of my Westover experience, and the School is where I made so many of my lifelong friends."

In addition, Lenkie added, "I have been happy to see other members of my family attend Westover [her daughters Leigh Keyser Phillips '68 and the late Liza Keyser Evans '73, and her granddaughter Hally Phillips Tremontozzi '97] and so I have seen firsthand the impact their experiences there have had on their lives, through the education they received, the confidence they gained, and the leadership opportunities it offered them. Because of their Westover experience, they have gone on to have successful lives and careers."

In addition to her daughters and granddaughter, Lenkie's other alumnae relatives include her late mother, Helen Cumming Angier, Class of 1919; and her late aunts, Elizabeth Cumming Halsey and Mary Cumming Driscoll, both Class of 1916.

I am thankful to have the resources available that can help make that happen through my gifts to the School."

Lenkie said she is particularly pleased that the renovations to the Senior Corridor will enhance the students' experience while living together in the dorm. "They need to have up-to-date dorm rooms, and the upgrades will give them a comfortable place to thrive. The renovations will help meet the needs of not just current but future students as well, as they prepare for life in college and beyond."

POOLED SCHOLARSHIP ESTABLISHED

The Westover Mosaic Pooled Scholarship—spearheaded by the Alumnae Board of Governors’ Diversity, Equity and Inclusion (DEI) Committee—was launched during the 2021–2022 academic year as part of the School’s ongoing commitment to build on the efforts undertaken by the DEI Task Force, which was created in 2020.

The Mosaic Pooled Scholarship invests in the next generation of empowered women through financial-aid support focused on equitable access for students of color. It was created as a pooled scholarship in the hope that as many donors as possible from within the School community will offer their support to enhance diversity at Westover.

For its 25th Reunion Gift, the Class of 1997 designated the Mosaic Pooled Scholarship as the recipient of its classmates’ gifts. In addition, other donors made designated gifts to support the scholarship, including Robin Smith Melvin ’80.

“This was very easy for me to do,” Robin said, as both a trustee and as a co-chair of the DEI Task Force. “I wanted to help provide a leadership gift to show my commitment, to put my money where my mouth is.”

“The ‘D’ in DEI is about diversity,” Robin said, “and, how I look at it, we need to get people of color through the doors of Westover and to the table. This scholarship will help increase the diversity of the student body.”

Robin knows from personal experience how important financial aid is to help create a diverse pool of students to access the opportunities that Westover has to offer.

“I needed aid to attend Westover,” Robin recalled. So, offering the Mosaic Pooled Scholarship at the School “is a very personal thing for me. I was very fortunate, because otherwise I would not have been able to attend Westover. And while there were scholarships when I was a student, obviously offering ones today designated specifically for students of color is more critical than ever.”

“For me,” Robin said, “the next step is the ‘E’ in DEI—the Equity piece needs to be there. Once you offer scholarships for girls of color to come to the School, to get them through the doors, we then must make sure that they are able to fully participate in the feast at the table. We must make sure they are able to take full advantage of what Westover has to offer, so that resources for them are not an issue.” She

noted that support must also be found to cover additional expenses—fees to take part in extracurricular programs offered by the School’s Rasin Center for Global Justice, the need for personal computers, or funds to participate in social activities offered by the School—that might limit these students’ access to the whole Westover experience.

“We need to make sure that resources are not an issue for anybody who doesn’t have the means from taking full advantage of what Westover has to offer,” Robin said. “That would be my goal as we move forward.”

Through endowed funds and through the Westover Fund, the School awards more than \$5 million in financial aid each year to nearly 64 percent of its student body. Financial aid is one of the top mission-critical Westover Fund designations, and the addition of the Mosaic Pooled Scholarship is intended to augment the School’s long-held commitment to supporting a diverse student body.
